# **SOUTH WALES BECOMES UK HEADQUARTERS FOR INTERNATIONAL LOGISTICS COMPANY**

The TWT Logistics Group is one of the fastest growing companies in its sector achieving growth of over 200% with an increase in sales from £5 million to £15 million over the last two years due to continued investment and substantial business growth.



Acquisitions throughout the UK means the Ystrad Mynach based company will be the headquarters responsible for delivering high quality transportation and logistics solutions across the UK and worldwide.



Managing Director of TWT Logistics, Trevor Taylor, started his business in the 1980's and has rapidly expanded from a 'one man and his truck' operation to employing 150 staff with a fleet of over 100 vehicles and 200 trailers. The number of staff employed at the site has increased more than 30% over the last two years.



Trevor Taylor has also committed £5 million of investment over the past two years expanding its fleet of vehicles, introducing cutting edge technology and increasing warehouse facilities. These major investments have helped TWT Logistics achieve exceptional transportation solutions for its blue chip clients.

In 2001 TWT Logistics joined Pall-Ex, the award winning pallet distribution network and is now there largest member. The Pall-Ex hub operation in Leicestershire is the first purpose built hub operation in its sector and is now the No.1 pallet network. In 2003 Trevor Taylor was



instrumental in the development of the revolutionary Pall-Ex hub operation and now TWT moves in excess of 100,000 pallets of freight per annum via this operation alone.

In February of this year TWT acquired Switch International, a worldwide logistics company based in Andover, Hampshire. On the 1<sup>st</sup> July 2006 Switch also joined Pall-Ex covering the surrounding postcodes to its Hampshire base as well as specialist services to both the Channel Islands and the Isle of Wight. The company's strategy to develop a network of operations has established TWT as a key player in their market sector.

Trevor Taylor, who has over 25 years in the logistics industry, said of current developments " TWT has enjoyed exceptional business growth in the last two years by investing in new technology and equipment which brings additional value to manufacturers and distributors operating in a competitive UK market"
